Anti-Snipe Feature

This auction uses an 'anti snipe' feature which means that if a bid is made within 5 minutes of close, the bidding time will be extended by 5 minutes. This is to reduce the instances of bidders 'sniping' at the last minute of the auction.

Inspections

All items in this auction have a formal inspection period. During this time bidders are able to inspect the lots they are interested in. It is the bidders responsibility to utilise this time to satisfy themselves with the condition of the lot. Inspections are recommended and will be deemed to have been taken in all cases.

Collection

All items purchased from a Ross's Auction must be collected by **4pm the next business day** unless otherwise stated. It is important that buyers are prompt in removing their purchased lots. Any items not collected within the allotted time period will incur a **storage fee from \$50 per item per day**.
